

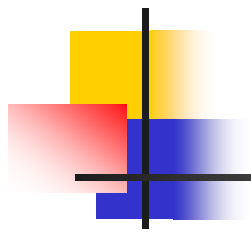

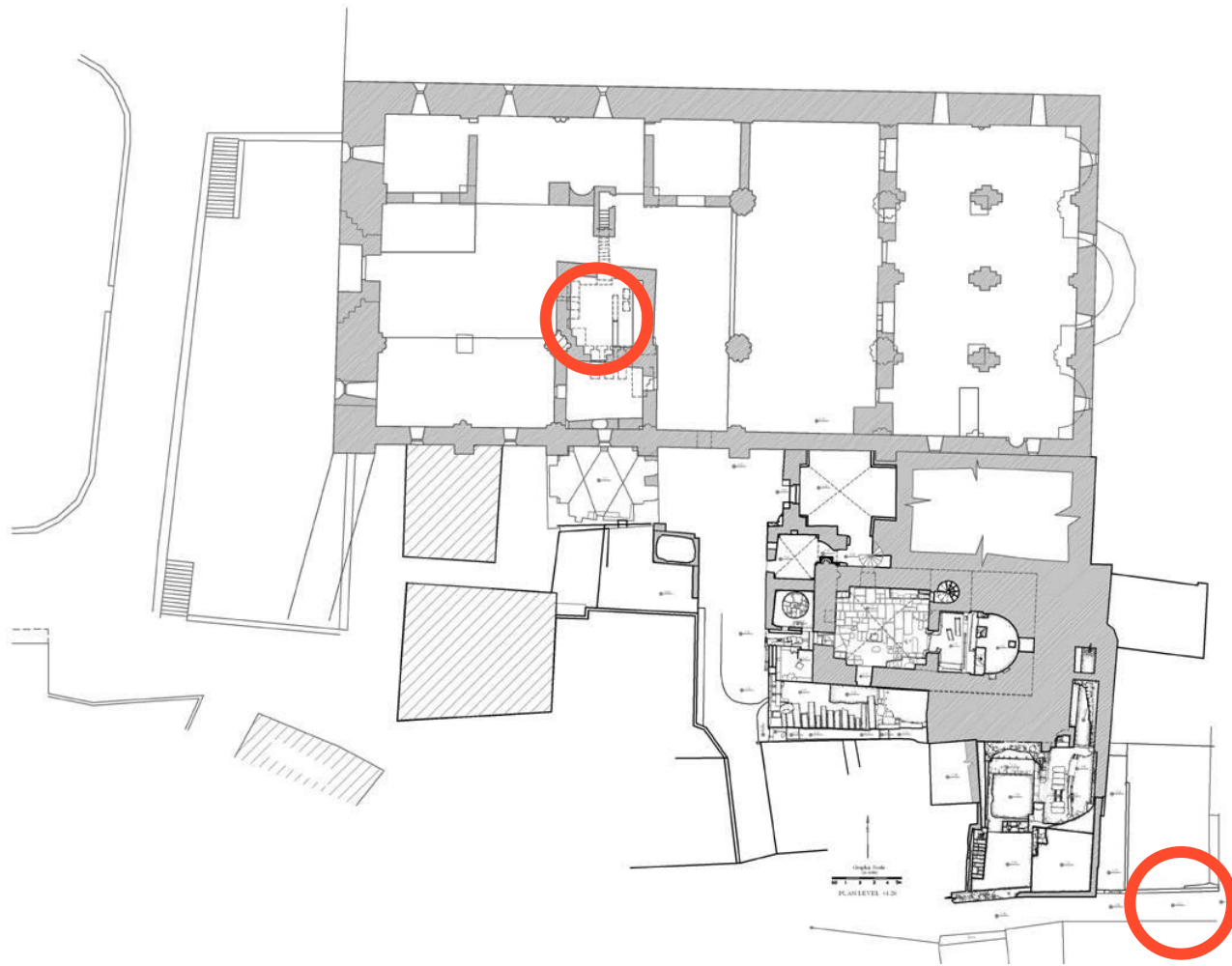
The Byzantine church in Sebaste in the 8th century floor mosaic in St. Stephan's church in Umm Rasas





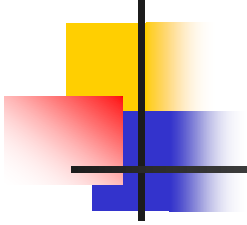
Remains of the Byzantine Church built over the Baptist's tomb

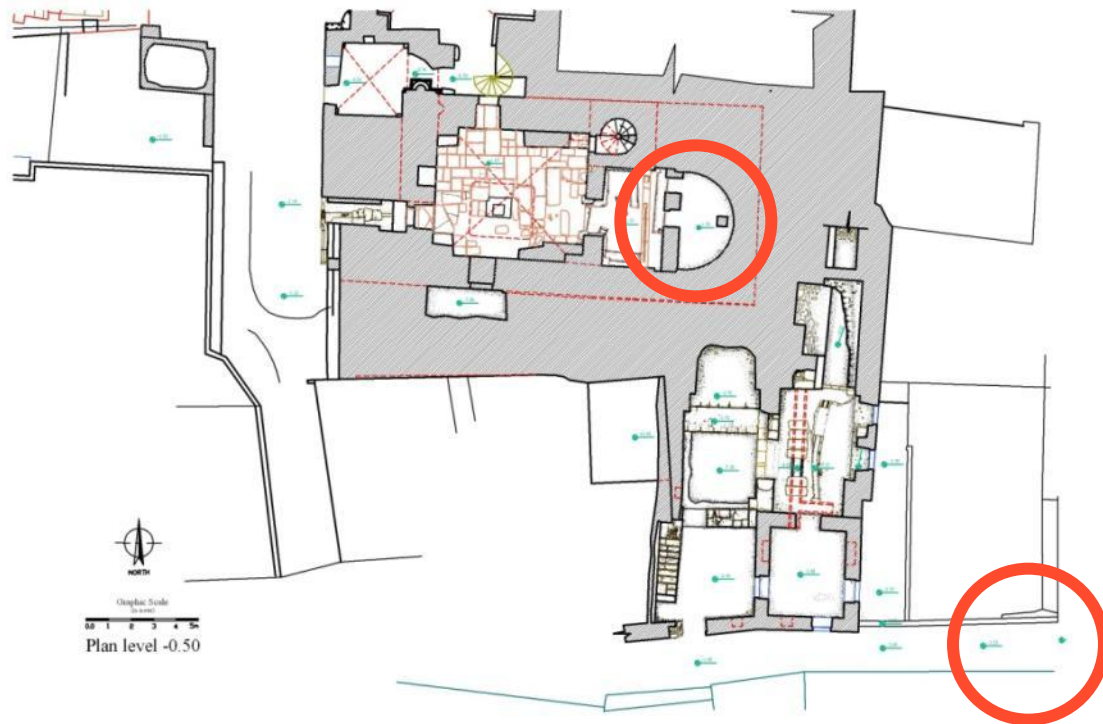
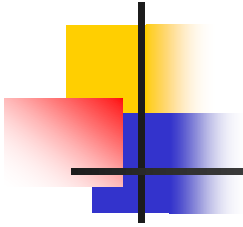




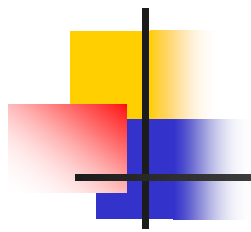
The location of the newly discovered mosaics in relation with John the Baptist's tomb (drawing Arch. Osama Hamdan











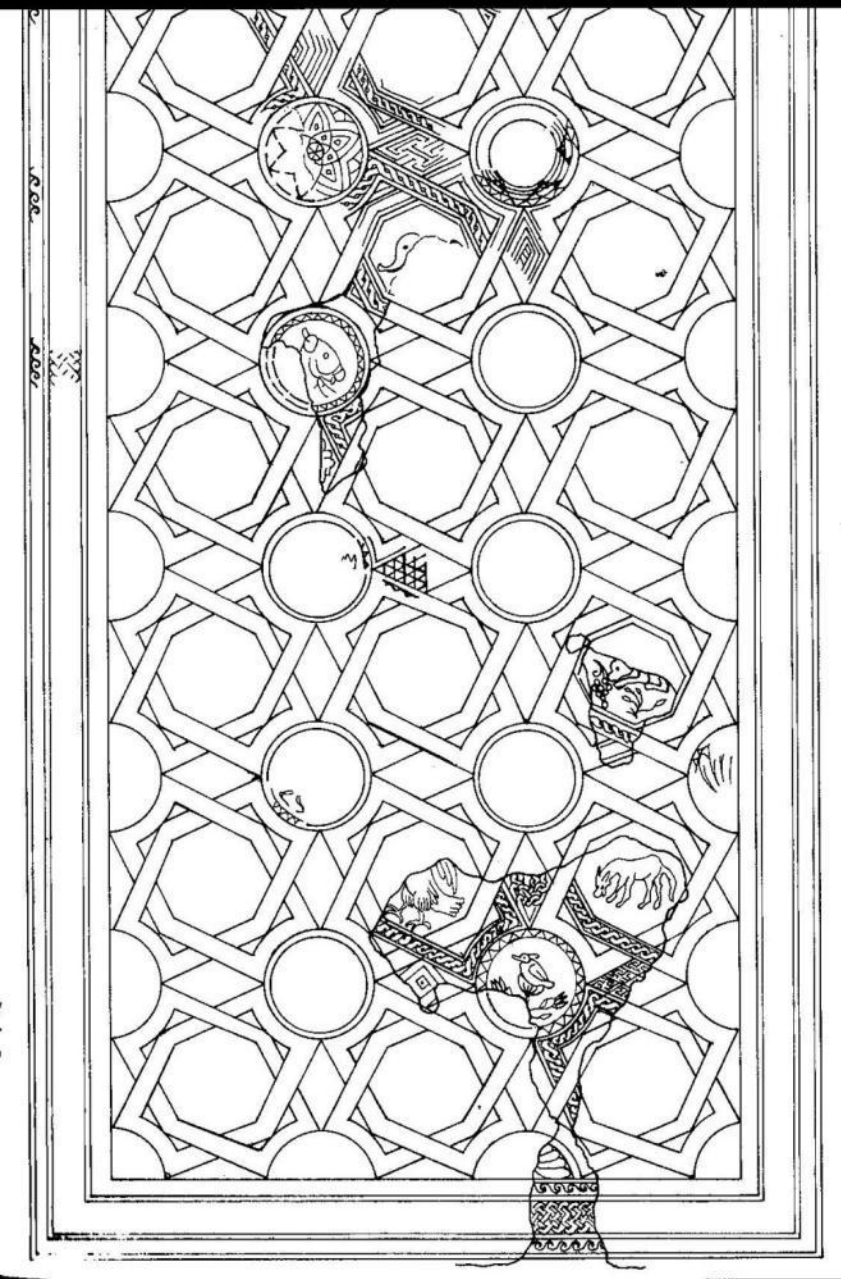

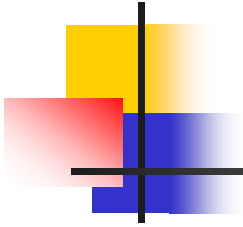
